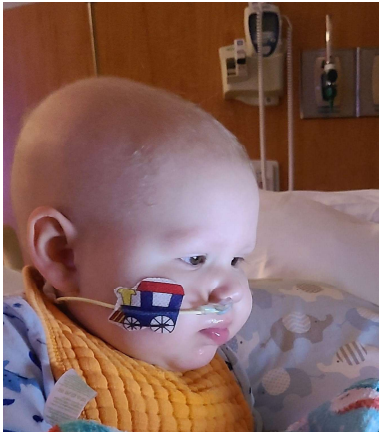




## ***Our Story***

Globally there are more than 300,000 children diagnosed with cancer each year. Every 3 minutes, somewhere in the world a family hears the devastating words that their child has been diagnosed with cancer.

Our Foundation was formed in 2021 through the inspiration of someone we love whose son was fighting a battle of their own. Charlie Ward was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia (ALL) in August 2020, just around the time of his first birthday. A group of friends and former

classmates of Charlie's father rallied together to provide initial financial and emotional support for the family.
